REFUND PROVISIONS

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL: You have the right to cancel this agreement for a course of instruction through attendance at the first class session (date: _____), or the seventh day after enrollment (date: _____), whichever is later for a full refund less \$250 non refundable deposit. Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the School shown on the top of the first page of the Enrollment Agreement. You can do this by mail or hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail is considered effective when received by Massage Center.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE:

You have the right to withdraw from a course of instruction at any time. The institutional refund policy for students shall be a pro rata refund. If you withdraw from the course of instruction after the period allowed for cancellation of the Agreement, which is at the first class session or the seventh day after enrollment whichever is later. You are obligated to pay only for educational services rendered. The amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, divided by the number of hours in the program), multiplied by the number of days student attended, or was scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal.

A pro rata refund shall be no less than the total amount owed by the student for the portion of the educational program provided subtracted from the amount paid by the student, calculated as follows: The amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, divided by the hours in the program), multiplied by the number of days student attended, or was scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal.

**IF THE AMOUNT YOU HAVE PAID IS MORE THAN THE AMOUNT YOU OWE FOR THE TIME YOU ATTENDED, THEN A REFUND WILL BE MADE WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF WITHDRAWAL.
IF THE AMOUNT THAT YOU OWE IS MORE THAN THE AMOUNT THAT YOU HAVE PAID, THEN YOU WILL HAVE TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO PAY FOR IT.**

Massage Center is an unaccredited institution and you will not be eligible for any Federal and State financial aid programs, since we do not participate in any State or Federal Financial Aid programs. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of monies not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.

HYPOTHETICAL EXAMPLE:

Assume that a student, upon enrollment in a 550 hour course, pays \$5500 for tuition, including a \$250 registration / deposit fee, and withdraws after completing 50 hours. The refund to the student would be \$4772.50 based on the calculation below.

- 1) \$5500 paid - \$250 registration fee = \$5250 for instruction
- 2) \$5250 for instruction / 550 hr = \$9.55 for instruction / hr
- 3) 50 hr x \$9.55 for instruction / hr = \$477.50 for instruction
- 4) \$477.50 for instruction + \$250.00 registration / deposit fee = \$727.50 retained by the school
- 5) The refund amount is \$5500.00 - \$727.50 = \$4772.50

STUDENT TUITION RECOVERY FUND (STRF)

The State of California established the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) to relieve or mitigate economic loss suffered by a student in an educational program at a qualifying institution, who is or was a California resident while enrolled, or was enrolled in a residency program, if the student enrolled in the institution, prepaid tuition, and suffered an economic loss. Unless relieved of the obligation to do so, you must pay the state-imposed assessment for the STRF, or it must be paid on your behalf, if you are a student in an educational program, who is a California resident, or are enrolled in a residency program, and prepay all or part of your tuition. You are not eligible for protection from the STRF and you are not required to pay the STRF assessment, if you are not a California resident, or are not enrolled in a residency program.

I understand the hourly breakdown of the 550 Hour Program is as follows: 164 hours of Basic Massage Instruction (the initial 11 weeks of class), 4 hour mandatory Ethics class, 16 hour mandatory Business class and 4 hour Medical Terminology, 237 hours of Advanced Elective classes (which I choose), 0-40 hours of Career Experience* and 125 hours will be done as Practical Experience* at the student clinic.

*Career Experience hours and Practical Experience hours are not compensated however hours are figured into hours completed for the program when/if student withdraws from the program and a prorated refund is due.
